**[PROPOSED] ORDER**

Upon consideration of the parties' cross-Motions for Summary Judgment, the briefs of the parties, materials submitted in support of and in opposition to the cross-Motions, and the arguments of counsel, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**, and judgment is hereby **ENTERED** in favor of Plaintiffs;

It is further ORDERED that 18 U.S.C. § 1715 and its implementing postal regulations contained within U.S. Postal Service Publication 52, including Publication 52 §§ 432.1 and 432.2, violate the Second Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, and;

ORDERED that Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order, are permanently **ENJOINED** from enforcing 18 U.S.C. § 1715 and its implementing postal regulations.
